SICKNESS

The medical guidelines which we follow concerning absence from school are as follows: If a child suffers from vomiting and/or diarrhoea, and is under the age of 5, then they should remain away from school for 48 hours after being symptom free. A child aged over 5 should remain off school for 24 hours.
